

Finding Which Version of FileMaker You're Running

This guide explains how to verify the version of FileMaker you're running. It is intended for general users.

Resolving software challenges sometimes hinges on having the current versions installed. In addition, your version of FileMaker Server, FileMaker Client, and aACE must all be compatible:

- FileMaker Server 16 and 17 both require FileMaker Client versions 15 or later
- aACE 6 requires FileMaker Server 18 or later
- aACE 5 requires FileMaker Server 16 or later
- aACE 4 is generally compatible with FileMaker Server 13 or later

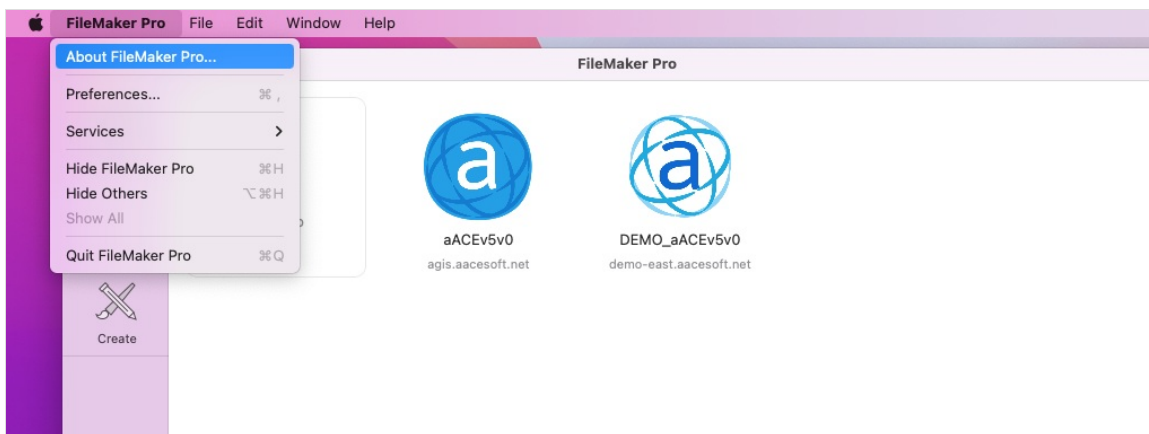
If you find that your current installation of FileMaker is *not* the most recent version, contact your system administrator for directions on upgrading.

Verify Your Version of FileMaker

If you are already logged in to your aACE system, you can find the version number by clicking Help > Check for Updates....

From the FileMaker Launch Center, you can also display the Version popup window, which shows the general version number and specific build number:

- FileMaker 17+ :
 - Click **FileMaker Pro Advanced > About FileMaker Pro Advanced**.



- FileMaker 16 :
 - Click **Help > About FileMaker Pro Advanced.**
