

# Understanding aACE Data Interchange (ADI)

This guide describes the aACE Data Interchange and its benefits. It is intended for system administrators.

aACE Data Interchange (ADI) is a series of data exchanges between an aACE system and external events. ADI is used to ensure data transfers smoothly for the [aACE Mailgun Integration](https://aace6.knowledgeowl.com/help/aacemailgun-email-functionality) and the [aACE Email Integration](https://aace6.knowledgeowl.com/help/understanding-aace-email-integration) (<https://aace6.knowledgeowl.com/help/understanding-aace-email-integration>).

Events and workflows enhanced by the aACE Data Interchange (ADI) include:

**Signature acknowledgements** (<https://aace6.knowledgeowl.com/help/vendor-acknowledgement>) added to Purchase Order correspondence. (No need to email back a scanned print-out. Just click a button, enter a signature and date, then click another button. The new signed document is picked up by aACE and saved to the related record, and logs are entered all automatically.) **Get your Orders confirmed quicker and easier!**

A “**Pay Now**” (<https://aace6.knowledgeowl.com/help/customer-pay-now-workflow>)” capability added to Invoice correspondence that allows a customer to immediately pay their bill via credit card (or ACH!). The email contains a link to a dedicated, secure payment processing site. Once completed, Receipts in aACE are auto generated and the authorization logged automatically. **Get paid faster and easier!**
